- B. Fine! Fine! You win! I can't take it anymore. (*Captain Kid stops whining*)
- A. Good! Now, it's time for you to get back to work and for me to go ride my bike.

Trapped

A. Someone Trapped in a Tower

B. The Rhymer, a Superhero

Situation: A villain has locked someone in a tower

- A. Help! Help! I'm trapped in this tower!
- B. I'll help you, my friend. I've got superpowers!
- A. *The Rhymer?* Is that you? You're so far away.
- B. It's me! It's true. I'll save the day.
- A. But *Rhymer*, do you have any real superpowers?
- B. I can rhyme anything, and I can fly to that tower!
- A. That's what I need. I'm stuck way up high!
- B. No worries, I'll get you, I just have to fly.
- A. You can fly? That's so cool! Hurry up and be quick.
- B. I'll be there in a jiffy, but where's my sidekick?
- A. You mean *Super Speller*, that kid who's so smart?
- B. That's him, he can spell, but he's no good at art.
- A. But I need to get out! I'm starting to worry.
- B. Hang on my friend, I'll be there in a hurry.
- A. The villain who took me will be back here soon.
- B. You must mean *The Climber*, that evil buffoon.
- A. Yes, he's the one. He locked me up here.
- B. We'll make him pay. Then we can cheer!
- A. Enough of this talking, I'm starting to dread.
- B. I'm flying on up there, so please watch your head.
- A. Save me! Save me! Please get here in time!
- B. To the rescue I come... with a smile and a rhyme!

Wake Up!

A. The Sleeper, a Villain B. The Caffeinator, a Superhero
Situation: A villain is confronted by a superhero.

- A. Ha! Ha! Ha! (*evil laugh*) My plan for world domination is working! I've put a sleeping potion on the entire planet. As soon as everyone falls asleep I can take control.
- B. Not so fast *Sleeper!*
- A. Oh it's you, *The Caffeinator*.
- B. You say that as if you don't like me.
- A. Why would I like you? You're my arch-nemesis.
- B. I'm just trying to save the world from supervillains like you.
- A. The world doesn't need saving. The world needs to go to sleep.
- B. And then what?
- A. Then I slip into their dreams and brainwash them to believe I am their leader.
- B. And what will you do once you're their leader?
- A. (*spitballing*) I'll... uh... well, I haven't decided yet.

- B. Deal. (*B. gives A. a cup of coffee and they drink.*)
- A. This is really good coffee.
- B. Thank you. They don't call me *The Caffeinator* for nothing.
- A. So, once I have control of the world I'm going to... (*falls asleep*)
- B. Ha! I've tricked you, *Sleeper*. That coffee was decaf with a shot of sleeping potion. Now you're the one to fall asleep. Nobody is taking over the world when *The Caffeinator* is on the job!
- A. (*snores loudly*)
- B. Sweet dreams!

A. Leader of Superhero Training Academy B. The Bookworm, Superhero in Training Situation: First day of superhero training

- A. Welcome to S.T.A., Superhero Training Academy.
- B. It's an honor to be here. I've been dreaming about this for years.
- A. Now, first things first, you will be given a superhero name.
- B. Oooh... like _____ or _____? (*Insert superhero names of your choice.*)

A. Super Selfie B. Lazy Boy
